
1- Artist: Haris Wasifi.

Title: The Illuminating lamp

Description: Quranic verses in the middle circle praising the Prophet "Indeed We have sent you as a witness and a bearer of good tidings for the believers and a warner, a caller to God by His permission and an illuminating lamp"

99 names of Prophet on the border in Naskh script. Also, Durood on the border in Diwani and Thuluth script along with gold miniature tazheeb work

Description: A bright and illuminating piece like the luminous character of the Prophet PBUH. This piece brings a soothing, refreshing feeling to the heart. The Hilye in Tuluth script is surrounded by the names of the four Caliphs and there is heavy illumination all around.



3- Artist: Mariyam Idrees Sandhu.

Title: Hilya Sharif.

Description: The Hilye of Prophet Muhammad PBUH. The artist has used classical illumination forms, using 24 carat gold and gouache paints.

Refined, Sophisticated and elegant piece is a classic.

A very classical rendition of the Hilye using ink on muqahhar paper. Calligraphy in Naskh and Thuluth style with Turkish Halkar tezhib on the border

A Hilya is a portrayal of the Prophet using Qur'anic verses and Hadith describing the Prophet Muhammad. These include a description of not only his blessed appearance, but also his beautiful character and merciful nature. The aim was for the reader to be able to imagine themselves in his blessed company.



4- Artist: Wagar Ahmed.

Title: Hilye Shareefa.

Description: 24k Real Gold on Ahar paper, black ink and pigment color. A very modern version of the Hilye.

Intermingling of illumination and geometry creates a serene yet astonishingly beautiful rendition of the Hilye.




5- Artist: Afaf Hassan.



Title: Hilya sharif of last Holy Prophet.

Description: A very distinctive and innovative attempt at the Hilye. Amazing symmetry and geometry in the center is surrounded by illumination all around the Hilye. Ornamental Kufic calligraphy has been used to write this Hilye which blends seamlessly with the ornaments.

Below the name is a circle is written ""Alam Nashrahh"" in old Kufic style in pastel scheme and behind this are the 4 names of our prophet in ""Khat e Sulus"".

Around the circle is written Surah Fatiha

In the blue curvilinear bands is written Darood e Ibrahemi in 2 opposite directions.

Ornaments and huroof abound and bring attention of the gaze to the center of this piece.


9- Artist: Usman Ghani

This piece is adorned with two verses in red ink. The revered names 'Mustafa' and 'Mujtaba' of Prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.H.) are inscribed in green ink, while 'sallallahu alaihi wa alayhi wa sallam' is elegantly written in blue, surrounded by fine illumination work"

Description: This bold yet elegant piece is a traditional calligraphy artwork on Muqahhar sheet, وما ارسلناك الا رحمة للعالمين in jali thuluth surrounded with 4 names of the Prophet

Marvels of Persian illumination with gold leaf work permeate the background to make this painting come alive.

Artwork symbolizes a visual theme of a galaxy in the universe. 4 names of Prophet represent the celestial bodies imparting their gleam of mercy to the darkness of entire universe.




11- Artist: Sajjad Anjum

The centerpiece of this work is the Name of prophet ""Muhammad SAW"" Using Golden shadow. The green hue of the Prophets dome is in the background.



Description: Eye catching, soothing and sublime ornaments surround for the name of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) using Rumi form. The serene elegance of this piece is sure to captivate your heart.




17- Artist: Sibt ul Hassan.


